

The **Mitacs** Exercise Accelerate

Background:

Mitacs is a national, not-for-profit organization that assists in designing and delivering research and training programs in Canada. Working with many universities, thousands of companies, and both federal and provincial governments, they build partnerships that support industrial and social innovation in Canada¹.

Mitacs Accelerate is Mitacs's research internship program. It connects companies with research-based universities through graduate students and postdoctoral fellows, who apply their specialized expertise to business challenges. The intent of this program is that interns transfer their skills from theory to real-world application, while the companies gain a competitive advantage by accessing high-quality research expertise².

In this exercise, MDM students will participate in the creation of Mitacs Accelerate grant applications. In addition, each group will act as referee for several Mitacs Accelerate grant applications.

Required:

Formation of Groups

- MDM students are to form groups of 3 or 4 students and nominate a "correspondent".
- The correspondent is to email aferworn@ryerson.ca with the names of the individuals in their group
- The correspondent will receive a secret fictional MDM student name to be used in the rest of the exercise.
- This name ***must not be disclosed*** to anyone outside of the group.
- The fictional name will be used to identify both the group and the Mitacs Accelerate application that the group will submit for adjudication. In other words, the fictional name will be used in the "name" fields of the application.

Creation of a MITACS "Accelerate" grant application

- Each group is to complete a Mitacs Accelerate application using the guide³ provided
- Ignore bullet points 4, 5, 8 and 9 of the instructions on the form.
- Use the secret student name provided to you as the name of the intern on the form
- The faculty supervisor should be "Alexander Ferworn"⁴
- Make an appointment with Michael Carter to be interviewed by a "Partner Organization"⁵
- The intern CV should be included (use a group member's but modify it to reflect the secret student name)
- No signatures are required in this exercise

Collaborative Workshop (W17)

- Save the application package in a .zip archive⁶ with the file name <first><last>.zip where “first” and “last” are the given and surname of the group’s secret student name respectively.
- The correspondent for the group should send the zipped application package to aferworn@ryerson.ca with the subject “Mitacs application for <secret student name>” no later than the due date.

Adjudication of MITACS “Accelerate” grant applications

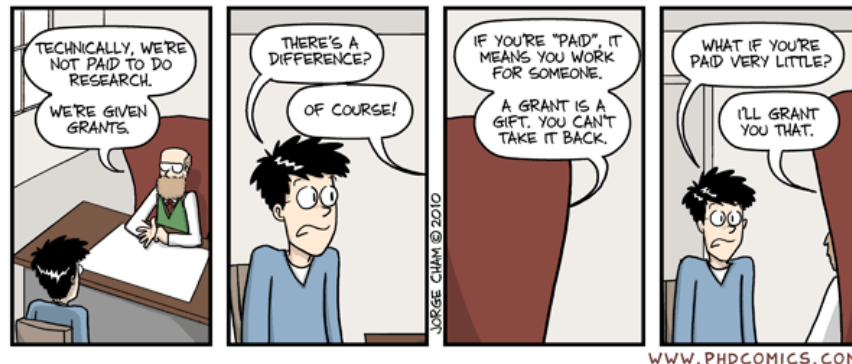
- Each group will receive 3 applications to review.
- Follow the guidance of the Mitacs guide for referees⁷.
- The group must rank their applications from best to worst
- The rejection of at least one application is mandatory

Referee Decisions Revealed

- On the date indicated, each group will make a brief presentation revealing their ranked list
- Reasons must be provided as to why the list was ranked the way it was
- Reasons why an application was rejected (other than it was mandatory to do so) must also be presented
